1900, it is a two-sided case, wood burl hollowed out in shape, to contain on each leaf 6 "Taji" for traditional cockfighting in Indonesia or Bali. These formidable spurs with four sharp faces, with engraved head, were tied with a red thread according to a traditional technique on the left paw of the fighting cock, this weapon allowing the fights to be less bloody, resulting in a rapid and more definitive outcome. The lugs have all been used, a little oxidation, some have marks (number of victories engraved?), Such a neat and important box must have belonged to a considerable family ... Dimensions: Box: 21cm x 10cm, Lugs: blades 8 to 12cm .. Condition: overall good.
