



Cabinet In Solid Walnut, Gothic Taste - Renaissance - Late 19th Century

Description

Cabinet in solid Walnut, generously carved, in the spirit of Gothic Religious Art. Its Pentagonal facade features, in the upper part and on each of its sides, the profile of a wearing figure. These representations, sometimes male and sometimes female, evoke the Henri II style. They are underlined by molded frames and topped with scalloped friezes. The angles are embellished with plant decorations arranged vertically. The central panel of this piece of furniture opens with a door fitted with a working lock and its key, all revealing a storage compartment furnished with a shelf. Below, integrated into the richly sculpted belt of this Cabinet, we discover a drawer 10.5 cm deep. Its facade is embellished with a reptilian creature spitting fire, surrounded by coats of arms. This ornate band overhanging a bare space

is supported on the sides by two straight uprights. On the front and on either side of the drawer, the angles are extended by sculptures in acanthus leaves and pine cones. Note that the bottom of the open niche also benefits from projecting frames and floral decorations. The whole rests on a high plinth with multiple moldings and cut legs. The back of the Cabinet is in Oak. One can imagine this Cossu Presentation piece of furniture starting its new life in a Property of Character, or in a renovated Château, in which we have been able to preserve the splendor of the old.
