Rare Cuban Mahogany Sideboard from the end of the 18th century. This Port Nantais cabinet is embellished on its Top with a Magnificent Flamed Marble of a deep black veined with white. Presenting projections on its front and rear sides as well as in its center, this Plateau is underlined by a Groove around its periphery. The Perfectly Symmetrical Front of this Unique Sideboard features Four Miter Cut and Entrance Doors, made up of a single panel of slightly Ruffled Cuban Mahogany. Surrounded by uprights with wide grooves separating the central part from the sides, these doors are provided with an iron and brass lock in working order, accompanied by their respective key. Inside, we find three shelves positioned on brackets, two cutlery drawers. Come to complete the storage
