Toque Mortier velours by JB Laval Prosecutor of King Louis XVIII, Very beautiful toque or mortar in moiré brown velvet and gold braid in its original box, this toque belonged to JB Laval, King's attorney and knight of the Legion of Honor, the box bears on its lid his name and the name of one of these descendants who had inherited it in 1884. JB Laval born October 1, 1783 La Platrière Lyon, Baptized October 14, 1783, died April 8, 1850 Ovilly 69. Lawyer in 1813, King's attorney 1817, Chevalier Légion D'honneur.
