Description

Large colorful Russian winter landscape created in ca. 1890-1900s by well-renowned Estonian-Russian landscape and genre artist Andrej Egorov(1878 Arukiüla by Revel (now Tallinn) - 1954 Tallinn). Untill 1921 he lived and worked in St. Petersburg, later in Tallinn. He was deaf and dumb, at first time of his Petersburg's life he studied in the special institute for deaf people, afterthen - in the Drawing School (OPH) in 1898-1901 and in the Art Academy by Ilya Repin and DHKardovsky (1902 -1904). In 1909 for his painting "In the village" he received title of master painter. Since 1911 he was a member of art society of Arkhip Kuinji and participant of exhibitions since 1907. main motives of his works nature and people of Russia and Estonia.
