Directoire skeleton clock (end 18th century) signed Gauchet et Fils at Livry. The dial in Roman numbers as 4 needles (hours, days, with corresponding greek symbols,

Sun-Moon-Mars-Mercure-Jupiter-Venus-Saturne) . Resting on 2 colums : at the top a guilt bronze basket, sphinges and garlands. On the front 2 Egyptien women and a crown. On the base , a freese and 4 adjustable feet. Underthe movment, a large drapingand a figure in the center, 2 sphinges, flowers and leaves. The glass front and back are convex and beveled.
