Description

Cut crystal goblet most certainly from Creusot* in Montcenis, in its leather case, circa 1830 Restoration-Charles X, 19th century. This cup is in good general condition, remarkable quality. A note: the case is damaged (broken hinge), micro-scratches and wear of time, see photos.

*Crystallerie du Creusot: In 1787, the King's Council of State decided to transfer the Queen's crystal factory from Sèvres to Montcenis. Built according to plans by Barthélémy Jeanson, the buildings house workshops, offices, accommodation for administrators and workers as well as the ovens, installed in two conical halls. Until its acquisition in 1832 by the establishments of Saint-Louis and Baccarat, the crystal factory enjoyed great influence. Eugène Schneider, who became manager of the forges and workshops in

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Le Creusot, bought the buildings of the former crystal works which he made his residence.
