Headdress badge of the company of jesus, restoration period, 19th century. In 1814, Pope PIE VII, by decree proceeded to the restoration of the company of Jesus. It was placed under the command of General Jean-Philippe ROTHANN, nicknamed the second founder of the company of Jesus. Domed oval center under crown between oak and olive branches. Hammered with a Christian cross and the letters "IHS". Fixing holes on the perimeter of the plate.
