Regional Val de Loire Transition style furniture in solid Cherry, with a mitred frame top enriched with moldings. It is composed of two rectangular doors with a mitred frame, embellished by a very sober interior molding, as well as by symmetrical center panels, in thick veneer on a chestnut interior, with a central joint for a wood effect. decorative. These openings have original brass hinges and entries, as well as an original lock in working order, provided with its key. The spacious interior discovers a fixed shelf. It also opens with two drawers with a small groove, fitted with handles and original "heart" entries in brass, note that the one on the right has a lock. This furniture rests on uprights with slightly cut sides, ending in snail's feet. A small, slightly cut-out low crosspiece brings elegance to this
