Small Spice Cabinet in Teak and Solid Rosewood. This magnificent century-old furniture was made by an Indian cabinetmaker in the tradition and particular style of furniture from the region of Pondicherry, a former French trading post in India. This piece of furniture in a modernized Louis XIV spirit has two narrow doors with a frame and crosspiece in Teak, as well as molded Rosewood panels with a flower bed. The upper part is fitted with asymmetrically shaped panes surmounted by a cornice. The sides benefit from four solid Teak flower bed panels. The interior is made up of three adjustable mahogany shelves on a rack and on cleats. We will appreciate the Personality that emanates from this Spice Cabinet, having benefited from careful work.
