In the lower part, two other Panels are decorated with an Oval Medallion in Cedar Burl ornamented with Light Wood Marquetry, representing a stylized Vase embellished with a Flower surrounded by foliage. The interior is lined with a modular shelf on racks. Each of the four panels has delicately chiselled oval brass pull handles. At the corners, four Curved Feet ending in Sabot adorn this Belle Époque Furniture. The Set is surmounted by a top in Solid Mahogany Molded in Doucine, framed by a Fillet of Rosewood and Lemon Tree.
