This leaf is equipped with a Lock in working order accompanied by its Key, everything is Original. The Facade of this Furniture is flanked on each side by two Cylindrical Columns in Burl Mahogany. Crowned with a beautiful solid Mahogany Ball, they are embellished with a finely chiseled Bronze element, of which the one in the upper part is ringed with a wider Collar.
