Serving console from the Napoleon III period, in solid mahogany and mahogany veneer. Its top consists of an elegant tray with a bec-de-corbin groove and molding around its perimeter. A pediment nicely carved with volutes embellishes it at the back, accompanied at each end by a piece turned into a spinning top. This piece of furniture opens in a belt by a drawer, decorated in applique with winding and foliage motifs, embellished with a macaroon in the center. It rests on the front on two very arched console legs in solid mahogany, carved in the upper part with a large acanthus leaf: they have the shape of a double volute, inverted in the middle, on which a graduated service shelf is supported. . A plinth, made up of a plinth and a cove molding matching the shape of the console, as well as two slab feet,
