Description

Work by designer Antonio Da Ros for the Cenedese glassworks, made in Murano glass through the submerged glass cabinet, datable to the 1960s.

The work is part of the collection developed by Da Ros in the sixties in collaboration with Cenedese di Murano, creating a line of works with stylized shapes, where the most important characteristics are the simplicity of the shapes, the preciousness of the material and the modernity of the colors. The glass in question is made with a clear-transparent glass of elongated shape, with a kind of round button in the upper part, inside there is a "bubble" of dark green glass, created through the glass showcase immersed. , identifying this collaboration .
