Silver frame encircling with 6 claws 12
OPERCULES of the TURBO shell or Tiger's Eye for the Mediterranean region. Shell that lives in rocky bottoms. This operculum is considered as 1 lucky charm, regularly worked for jewelry. The operculum closes the entrance to the shell of a mollusk. Hard natural material, mineralized product of different tones, here green and brown.
