Magnificent Mirror with Beadings with gilt wood surrounds. It is composed on each side of Pilasters with Mercury Silver Glass, dressed on the upper and lower parts of Cut-out Sculptures in Flowery Motifs. These Pilasters are topped with Silver Glass Rectangles, themselves crowned with a beautiful Shell with Volutes. Its upper part has a "Gendarme's Hat" shape, made up of four Glass Elements. They are separated from each other by Wood Elements in Sheath with Projecting Patterns. This Pediment is embellished with a Pattern with three Sculpted branches, surrounded on each side by a Fallen Flowers and Foliage. The lower part of this Decorative Object is divided into three sections: two small Mirrors at the ends surrounding a longer one in the middle. The main Ice, of Origin and with
