



Small Showcase In Rio Rosewood, Transition Style Louis XV - Louis XVI - 2nd Part Nineteenth

Description

Small Showcase at Support Height, essentially composed of Rio Rosewood Veneer arranged in Herringbone. It opens with a door provided with a keyhole, its key and a lock in working order. The glazed space is underlined by a brass rod with Doucine forming a frame. The interior offers three 24.5 cm deep shelves, placed on racks and therefore adjustable as desired over a total storage height of 92 cm. The belt of this piece of furniture is curved and lined with lemon tree inlays on its three visible sides. It offers on the front a small drawer with the same lines, assembled in Dovetails and provided with two ornate Bronze pull handles. The sides of this Showcase are also embellished with Lemon Frames but of larger dimensions. The top tray is embellished with a Rosewood motif on four-sheet veneer. It stands

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out from the rest of the furniture by its very light color but is nevertheless delimited by a discreet net of lemon tree. The front uprights of this piece of furniture are adorned in the upper part with Bronze Chutes and finished with Sabots of the same alloy. The back feet are straight. It should be noted that all the ornaments of this Showcase are original. This piece of furniture at Support Height benefits from interesting dimensions, adapted to surfaces that would possibly be reduced, while bringing the cachet expected of a 150-year-old Antiquity.
