Description

Louis XVI cylinder desk in solid Cuban mahogany for the legs, sides and drawers and veneer for the cylinder and the shelf. Oak fund. It opens with a cylinder, a shelf and three drawers in two rows. The cylinder discovers a locker and 4 small drawers, 1 of which is compartmentalized. The tablet is covered with an old leather of 37cm X 29cm. It offers a work surface of 93.5cm X 38cm at 74cm from the ground. It rests on 4 fluted sheath feet ending in bronze sabots. Fluted uprights. Bronze keyholes and pull buttons. It bears the stamp of Antoine NICOLAS received Master on September 3, 1765 - Parisian cabinetmaker, he had to retake his master's degree by settling in Nantes - Jurande de Nantes hallmark of 1777 or 1787.
