was born in Bourbonnes-les-bains, began painting
in 1919 and presented his first works during an
exhibition of Franc and Comtois painters in
Luxeuil-les-bains, then in Belfort and Langres. In
1928, he became a member of the Salon of
French Artists and exhibited at the 1937
