### Description

Empire-style children's bed in mahogany and mahogany veneer - For a standard 190cm x 80cm mattress and base. Dimensions: length 205cm, height 70cm x 80cm, depth 101cm. Good overall condition. International shipping available. This small Empire-style bed, made between the late 19th and early 20th centuries, is distinguished by its restrained and rigorous interpretation of forms inherited from the First Empire. Crafted from solid mahogany and mahogany veneer, it features an architectural structure characterized by clean lines and a strong symmetry. The headboard and footboard have a rectangular profile, each composed of panels that highlight the warm and nuanced grain of the wood, demonstrating joinery and cabinetmaking attentive to the aesthetics of the material. The posts are formed by freestanding

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columns, typical of the Empire style, evoking classical antiquity. These columns are accentuated by finely chiseled gilt-bronze ornamentation, which vertically rhythms the composition and provides an elegant contrast to the deep mahogany hue. The upper ends of the posts feature softened scrolls, lending the piece a certain monumentality tempered by the simplicity of its proportions. The side rails, also made of mahogany, ensure visual continuity with the main panels. The entire piece rests on discreet, integrated legs, contributing to the overall stability of the furniture. Designed to accommodate a standard 80 x 190 cm mattress and bed base, this bed combines functionality and formal elegance. It is a representative example of late 19th-century production inspired by the Empire style, where the historical reference is reinterpreted with a certain restraint, prioritizing the quality of the materials and the purity of the lines.
