# Description

Ancient terracotta relief created ca. 1900-1920 on the famous Austrian porcelain and ceramics factory of Carl Ernst David Wahliss (1837 Sachsony -1900 Vienna), who had factories in Turn\_Teplitz and Vienna, probably by his sons Hans and Erich, who took over the paternal business in 1905, the manufactory had trade in London, England and Vienna. This terracotta relief has a very interesting subject bearing witness to this era and humorously showing a family of monkeys from Morocco at the cafe and reading the advertisement about emigration to America by sea from Spain.
