These armchairs have a walnut base with two curved and grooved front legs. A slightly rounded front crosspiece also with a groove connects these two legs. In the rear part, two reversed straight legs complete these seats. Ideal in your living room or bedroom, these two Napoleon III armchairs, synonymous with relaxation and comfort, will give your decoration a timeless charm.
