About the collection: This collection is the story of the personification of the resident flowers of the fairy palace as women. these get to be able to come down to earth to judge the admiration they arouse and the powers they can derive from it. whether it is the daisy, the poppy, the cornflower or even here the tulip, their earthly history is told in turn, with humor.
