Joseph Henri François Van Leries (December 23, 1823, Antwerp - February 29, 1876, Mechelen) was a Belgian painter of the romantic-historical style. Van Leries painted mythological and biblical scenes as well as portraits and genre images. Much of his work is didactic in nature. In 1852, Queen Victoria bought his painting "First Born".

This painting of a young couple with a baby is still on display at Windsor Castle.
