Very beautiful glass cage clock, from the Napoléon III période.

Annular dial in enamel with Roman numerals, revealing the escapement (Brocot) in the center. Breguet hands in burnished steel.

Movement in gilded brass, with anchor escapement, with ruby levers, signed Marty. this movement won a bronze medal in a competition in 1860. astonishing bronze pendulum balance with glass center.

Strike of the hours and a half at the passage on gong. Eight days of power reserve.

Gilded brass cage, glazed on all four sides.
