It rests on two Turned Columns with Stopped Grooves, thus forming a Niche. The bottom of it is embellished in the central part with a Mercury Ice with Molded Frame. Below, this Property opens with two imitation curtain doors. One of them is provided with its Lock and its Key. The interior offers a storage space furnished with a removable shelf placed on fixed cleats. The Sides present four Rounded Shelves surrounded by a Brass Gallery which echoes that of the Upper Tray. The set is enriched by four uprights, which take up the Fluted Decor mentioned above. They end with four
