He studied drawing at the School of Applied Arts in Paris then in 1946, he moved to Vallauris after discovering ceramics and decided to devote himself to this medium. In 1952, he bought a disused pottery there and opened a shop and began to produce objects and panels; three years later, he began making pieces for the table. during the 1960s, he made several collaborations with
