the enameled dial features both Roman numerals for hours and Arabic numerals for minutes. The horological mechanism boasts a double-ended movement with an anchor escapement and steel suspension, indicative of sophisticated 18th-century clockmaking. Rich Symbolism and Classical Motifs:

The gilt bronze casing is richly adorned with allegorical and classical motifs: At the very top, a trophy symbolizing hope is prominently displayed, symmetrically flanked by two beautifully rendered small trees, creating distinctive accents for the timepiece.
