Our opinion: Sublime, each fine pearl is unique and has a magnificent luster. Very rare of this size and shape, they are particularly well highlighted by the old diamonds that surround them. The mounting in pendant earrings is sober and very elegant.

The story of this jewel: These old dangling earrings are the result of a probable reassembly after the 19th century. The patterns are much older and most likely come from an adornment dismantled during a family succession.
