Description

Jean-Louis Brémond (1858-1943): "La provende des poules", etching 39 X 29 cm on paper 56 X 46 cm, mounted in a molded oak frame 64 X 53 cm. Stamped, signed and dedicated "To the Master ceramist of Vallombreuse". Many light foxing in the margin and small wetting at the foot. Le Bénézit tells us that the author was a painter and engraver, exhibitor at the Salon and illustrator of numerous works. The dedicatee is, of course, Henri de Vallombreuse (1856-1919), painter and ceramist of the Art-Nouveau period who worked in Saint-Armand en Puisaye. If the Art of the print has fallen somewhat into disuse, requiring taste, skill and patience from its amateurs, there was a time when beautiful sheets like this one were highly prized... The bite of the plate by water -forte is deep and seems to vibrate,
