Pierre-Eugène MONTEZIN (Paris 1874-Moëlan-sur-Mer 1946) He was trained by his father, a lace designer. He was refused ten years in a row at the Salon, from 1893 to 1903. After the war, he found his style, a clever pastiche of impressionism, thanks to which he took his revenge at the Salon des Artistes français by obtaining many awards. His landscapes, lightly
