Set of two Charles X period armchairs, due to their rarity, in particular their light ash structures. They have been covered in the traditional way with tapestries from "Prestigious Textiles". More specifically, the padded backrests are upholstered in the "Melbourne graphite" model with nail finishes, while for the seats, which are just as comfortable, the "Kedleston Graphite" fabric has been chosen, all harmonizing perfectly. . These armchairs are equipped with armrests with large butts. They rest on "hock" feet at the front and "swords" at the back. The barrels have been squared for optimal solidity. This pair of seats may or may not be accompanied by a fully matching chair since it comes from the same set (reference 1027 P Ter). We will remember the beauty of the ash used for the design of these
