Master goldsmith "Marret et Jarry" rue vivienne in Paris, pretty round dish in Louis XV style in solid silver 1st title, it has a contoured border with wide strong nets, the wing is engraved with coat of arms of alliance under count's crown, it bears the Minerva hallmark and on the back in full the name of the Goldsmith (45 rue Vivienne in Paris dimensions diameter 27cm pid 725g in good general condition, small scratches from use The house Marret Jarry and Gaimn master Goldsmith in Paris rue Vivienne was active only from 1851 to 1858 19th century Parisian work
