

First state,

original etching engraved by Valerianus Regnartius for his series on Roman Churches. Valérian Regnart (active in Roma between1626 to 1650 circa) was a french engaver, living in the fierst half of the XVIIth c.

Published in Roma by François Collignon in 1650, without any title, but in a set known as: Praecipia urbis templa the plates show elevations, sections and plans of
