Pendulum and Urn In Neo-Greek Style By Ferdinand Barbedienne (1810-1892) and Louis-Constant Sévin (1821-1888). Etruscan clock in black marble and decorated with polychrome champlévé enamels, the angles are decorated with mascarons in high relief representing masks of bearded men and separated by a frieze of Virginia creeper in champlévé enamel. The dial is also enamelled and the movement needs to be reviewed, the pendulum is missing, the glass on the back is broken, the clock bears the signature of the manufacturer, publisher and founder F.BARBEDIENNE and attributed to the designer-decorator Louis-Constant Sévin .
