Excellent conditions This magnificent work, a true pearl of the early Renaissance Lombard, is obviously linked to the catalog of Giovan Pietro Rizzoli called the Giampietrino, Leonardo da Vinci's favorite pupil. In addition to the stylistic characteristics, truly unique and incomparable, the attribution is attested by comparisons with some of his similar paintings, in particular with the table exhibited in the Museum of the Diocese of Milan, which unequivocally presents the identical pictorial peculiarities.
