They rest on a fluted pedestal, overhanging a finely chiselled collar of scallops. The set rests on a square section base with small cut sides, in beautifully crafted and openwork bronze. This pair of bewitching onyx and sparkling bronze vases will undoubtedly enhance the room in which you decide to place it.
