PECTORAL ORNAMENT

Highlands or the Highlands region, Papua New Guinea

Early 20th century

Shell and vegetable fibers

H.: 25; L.: 22; Thickness: 9 cm

(Small accident)

This ornament is made of a large shell, the melo amphora called "pakol" pierced three times on the upper edge. A braided cord of vegetable fibers was used to hang it from the neck. The patina of the shell tends slightly towards orange-red on the lower part.

This ornament was worn by men as well as by women on the occasion of ceremonies. It was
