### Description

Thierry Michelet XVIII (1958-2013): "Romulus and Remus", painting on canvas approximately 200 X 200 cm. Trained at the Beaux-Arts in Bordeaux, he is part of a neo-expressionist current which finds echoes almost everywhere in Europe: Baselitz, Fetting, Salomé or Penck in Germany, Clemente or Chia in Italy, Garouste or Blais in France or Barcelo in Spain among many others, each finding a different way of expression, but with an obvious relationship, a visceral, strong, often colorful and fast painting, which does not mean sloppy! He had many exhibitions both in France and abroad with works acquired by museums. The works that I present to you today were hunted down more than 30 years ago at the Foire des Quinquonces: I had come to a halt in front of those exhibited on the front of two
