Beautiful and large biscuit porcelain sculpture on an oval base representing a cherub or cupid holding a garland of roses near an antique vase with torch and quiver. Work signed H. Moreau for Hippolyte Moreau (1832-1927). Nice size group with great decorative power. A factory mark below. Very good condition, some cooking cracks blocked with plaster (the main one on the left shoulder of the cherub). Period early 20th century.
