



## Miniature Powder Pear, Carved Walnut, Bagnard Work, 1819 Period, Gold Frame, Rare.



## Description

Small carved natural walnut, on one side a cartouche in the shape of a coat of arms with draperies allowing to put the initials, a dog lying down and two doves as well as foliage and finally on the top and bottom of the friezes, the whole representing a pear with miniature powder, gold mount, which is extremely rare, belcher chain, what is called the work of convicts or sailors, later, this one was mounted in gold in Paris around 1819, Charles X period , gross weight of 6.47 gr, often offered for engagement or marriage or other family celebrations, documents provided for more information. All the various taxes or customs fees for foreign countries are the responsibility of the buyer.
