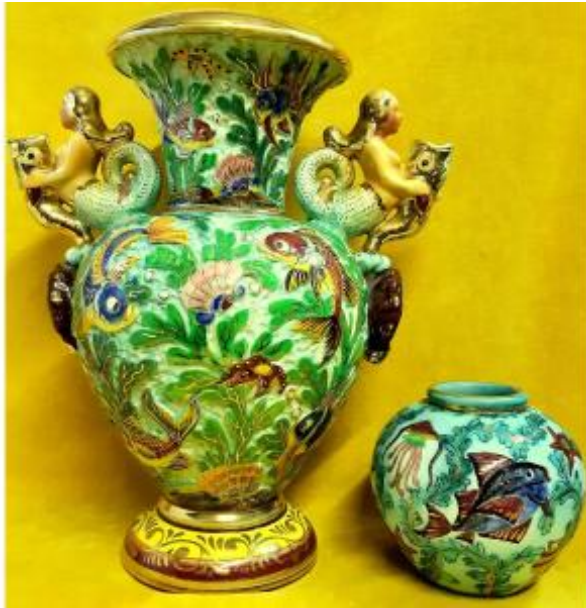




Very Large Baluster Vase Taken Mermaids Earthenware Cerdazur Monaco 1950

Description

After 1946 in Monaco, many small ceramic workshops emerged, one of the best known being the Cerdazur workshop. The post-war reconstruction period and the baby boom brought about a joyful and colorful production. This large vase is an example. Its baluster shape has a decoration on a scarified and incised green background of the seabed with seaweed, shells and moving fish in a rotating decoration on the whole of the vase ending with a flared neck underlined in gold. The 2 side sockets are 2 mermaids hugging huge fish with their mouths open.
