Rare and beautiful little cabinet in marquetry of different species of black stained wood and native wood, it opens on the front with two doors and discovers an interior consisting of 8 drawers 4 small and 4 larger, the central part opening with a door. The rich decor interior contrasts with the sobriety of the exterior. The rich interior decoration with a hunting theme includes many quality details, such as foliage, animals: hares, fox, wolves, squirrel, weasel, against a backdrop of landscapes, castles and villages, three hunters and or piqueux complete this "rich" decor. We find in Lorenz Stoer's book "GEOMETRIA ET PERSPECTIVA" published in 1567 inspirations which "helped" the craftsman to create the cabinet presented here.
