Beautiful suite of 8 dining room chairs in solid mahogany and mahogany veneer.

They rest on front feet called "hock" and rear saber feet.

Beautifully crafted, these chairs are stamped in ink inside the "Jeanselme" belts. The Jeanselme house is a dynasty of Parisian cabinetmakers active from 1824 until the end of the 19th century. Suppliers of the courses of Louis-Philippe and Napoleon III, they bought in 1847 the funds of the Jacob house.
