An infinite and exceptional palette of colors with rich, highly contrasting tones, a background worked in reserves using the artist's usual technique, a perfectly mastered touch for this post-impressionist artist largely influenced by Fauvism. He first studied at the Beaux-arts in Marseille then in Paris in the studio of Jean-Léon Gérôme. He became curator of the Museum of Arles from 1924 to 1941. He won the Grand Prix de Rome.
