Gold and enamel pendant with Christ and the Virgin. French, 17th century. A gold and enamel double sided devotional pendant painted with the busts of Christ and the Virgin.

Probably originally a pendant from a rosary, it is now mounted on a string of pearls with gold beads and diamonds.

French, first half of the 17th century.

The enamel measures 2.8 x 2.2cm.

In unrestored and untouched condition, the pearls will require a clasp to be worn.
