



Mahogany Flying Table Stamped Canabas



Description

This table opens with a drawer on the right side. Its belt is mahogany and mahogany veneer. It rests on four sheathed feet ending in casters and bronze shoes connected by a spacer shelf also in mahogany. It is also fitted with a sliding screen lined with Lyon silk. According to Kjellberg, Canabas is considered "the grand master of small mahogany furniture". Work stamped on the upright of the rear foot Canabas (Jean Joseph Gengenbach dit) (1712_1797) Received master in 1766. L: 51 / P: 32 / H: 77
