ornament is inspired by a hymn which reminds us that it is in a garden with rare essences, planted with fragrant flowers and delicious fruits, that the games of mystical love, because the soul is a garden. Petit point embroidery, edged with a band of gold thread. France from the beginning of the 18th century.
