Provenance of a famous French collection which

with Hispano-Moorish decoration, it is about two
belts sewn in their middle probably at the era.
Upside down, the ikat weave is as interesting as
the right side up. Patina of use and some missing
fringes, but stable condition. Dimensions: 13 cm
wide by 254 cm long. This belt comes from a set
of 12 pieces that decorated a castle in the South
West of France in the Bordeaux region. Le

magazines of the 1970s, associated with French
