"Rare pair of Charles X period shelves in sycamore and amaranth wood" Placed on four clogs on wheels, the spindle-shaped maple uprights make up five floors held by X-shaped spacers connected in their center by small amaranth cabochons. The crosspieces hanging the tables are also in amaranth as well as the strapping of the spindles. The highest shelf is made up of an openwork step whose ends are in the shape of an ogee.
